Home and school factors as correlates of psychological adjustment of adolescents with hearing impairment in Ibadan, Oyo State, 2011.

The study examined the relationship among home and school factors and the psychological adjustment of adolescents with hearing impairment. Purposive sampling technique was used to select 120 participants from two integrated secondary schools in Ibadan. A survey research design was used in carrying out the study. The data collected in the study was analysed with Pearson Product Moment Correlation, ANOVA and Multiple Regression. The result showed that home and school factors had significant correlation with psychological adjustment of adolescents with hearing impairment. recommendations for enhancing the psychological adjustment of adolescents with hearing impairment were made.
